## Regular plurals

| Nouns ending in $\begin{aligned} & -s,-s s,-s h,-c h, \\ & -x,-0 \end{aligned}$ | bus glass tomato | buses <br> glasses <br> tomatoes |
| BUT | photo | photos |
| Nouns ending in vowel $+-y$ | toy | toys |
| Nouns ending in consonant $+-y$ | strawberry | strawberries |

We use $a$ before words beginning with a consonant: a friend, a bird.
We use an before words beginning with a vowel: an iguana, an artist. There are no articles for plural words: peppers, iguanas, three books.
