About the writer

About the programme

Flatline is episode 9 of the eighth *Doctor Who* series. The Doctor is played by Peter Capaldi and his companion, Clara, by Jenna Coleman.

Summary

This story is set in Bristol, which has been invaded by aliens from a two-dimensional world. When the Doctor and Clara arrive in the TARDIS they find that people have been killed and turned into two-dimensional forms, as pictures on the walls of an underpass. In time, the beings begin to understand three dimensions and change their victims into blurred shapes, which they use to hunt down more people. Normally, the Doctor could defeat these aliens but they have drained energy from the TARDIS and shrunk its size, so he can't get out or use any of the machine's systems. Clara, in the city, must save the situation.

Chapter I: In a flat, a frightened man is making a telephone call to the police. He is seized by an unknown force and pulled down into the floor, leaving only a large image of his face on the wall. The TARDIS lands in Bristol, which disturbs the Doctor as he'd planned to land in London. When they are outside, the Doctor and Clara find that the TARDIS has shrunk. Clara goes off to investigate while the Doctor squeezes back into the TARDIS to try and understand what's happened.

Chapter 2: In a shopping centre, Clara speaks to Rigsy, a graffiti artist now on Community Payback. A small team

is painting over graffiti, some of which is Rigsy's. Later, in a nearby underpass, he tells Clara that several people have gone missing recently, and pictures of them have appeared on the walls.

Chapter 3: Clara returns to find that the TARDIS has now shrunk so much that the Doctor can't come out of its door. He passes her his sonic screwdriver, psychic paper and an earpiece to let her communicate with him. He asks her to carry the TARDIS with her as she rejoins Rigsy.

Chapter 4: Rigsy takes Clara to the flat of the last person who disappeared, where they find nothing wrong. There is a strange mural of what looks like dry earth on one wall. Clara suggests that the man might still be in the room but shrunk to a very small size. She starts to look under the sofa. This frightens Rigsy, who moves towards the door. Clara stops him from leaving by taking the TARDIS out of her bag and telling the Doctor to open the door and introduce himself. Then the TARDIS shrinks even further. Clara and Rigsy run out of the flat.

Chapter 5: With the help of PC Forrest, they enter the flat of the first disappearance and the Doctor tells them to knock down a wall as he suspects that the people have disappeared into the walls. In the next room, PC Forrest is suddenly pulled into the floor and a painting appears on the wall. The Doctor realises that the mural and the painting represent aspects of the human body. He says that the attacks are coming from aliens that are trying to understand three dimensions. Then the door of the room closes and the handle flattens. The Doctor tells Clara to keep away from the walls. Clara and Rigsy climb into a hanging chair and Clara uses the sonic screwdriver to pull them through the window. During the escape she takes a call from Danny. He's concerned because she's late for their date in London. Clara and Rigsy land in the garden, inside the chair.

Chapter 6: They return to the underpass, where the community workers are about to start painting over the pictures on the walls. The Doctor tells Clara that these are the actual victims. When one of the workers, Stan, touches the wall with his brush, he is pulled into it. Clara leads the others to an old railway building.

Chapter 7: The Doctor, Clara and the others try to communicate with the creatures using the TARDIS' translation ability, but the creatures turn another of their group into two dimensions. The rest escape into a tunnel.

Chapter 8: Clara finds that the handle of a nearby door, shaped like a metal wheel, has been flattened. Then a giant hand grabs another of the workers and takes him away. Dark shapes rise up from the tunnel floor. The creatures have learned how to become three-dimensional and have taken on the shapes of their former victims. The group runs away from them. The Doctor gives Clara a device which restores a door lock to three dimensions. They reach the top of a ladder, where Fenton tries to grab the TARDIS. It slips from his fingers and falls down a hole.

Chapter 9: The TARDIS lands on a train track and there's a train coming. The TARDIS has no energy but the Doctor gets it off the track by pushing his hand through the door and walking with his fingers. A second train approaches and Clara stops it by changing the signal to red. They use the train to try to ram the creatures but it is simply transformed into a two-dimensional image. As they run away again, Clara finds the TARDIS, now shut down into a small cube, and takes it with her.

Chapter 10: In a disused office, Clara gets Rigsy to paint a realistic-looking door on the back of a large poster. They hang this up in a tunnel, with the TARDIS behind it. When the creatures try to unflatten the painting, they pour energy through it into the TARDIS. This restores its functions. The Doctor sends the creatures back to their own dimension with a warning never to return.

Chapter II: The Doctor, Clara, Rigsy, the engine driver and Fenton leave the TARDIS. Rigsy borrows Clara's phone to call his mother. The engine driver and Clara embrace. The Doctor and Fenton argue about the value of those who died, then Fenton and the engine driver leave. The Doctor tells Clara that she saved the world. He compliments Rigsy on his painting. Clara and Rigsy shake hands then Rigsy leaves. Clara's phone rings. It's Danny but she doesn't want to talk to him at that moment. She asks the Doctor to say she was a very good Doctor, and he does so.

Background and themes

Social class: Rigsy is a young man from an ordinary background. He is a talented artist but can only express himself through graffiti. He may or may not have a future as a painter. How different would Rigsy's life be if he came from a middle-class home and was destined for art school? Ask students: *Do you think Rigsy has a future as a painter?* Is graffiti a good thing for an artist to do? If Rigsy came from a better-off family, would his life be different?

Clara's conflicts: Throughout the story, Clara reflects on whether she should continue to travel on the TARDIS, and if she was successful in the role of the Doctor. The former involves her in some rather evasive conversation with her boyfriend Danny and not totally frank reports of it to the Doctor. The latter sees her trying to get some recognition from the Doctor that she has actually done a good job. Ask students: Do you think Clara should travel again with the Doctor or go back to her boyfriend? Do you think the Doctor should praise Clara more at the end of the story?

Heroism: Rigsy is doing Community Payback because he has broken the law by painting graffiti. However, he is helpful to Clara from the beginning, and on the train he shows that he is ready to die for the others. Also, it is his painting that saves them in the end. What does this tell us about stereotypes and the way society sees people?

Sacrifice: 'But it's like a forest fire, isn't it?' Fenton said. 'You try to save the big trees, not the little ones.' Fenton thinks that the deaths of the Community Payback workers were not important compared to the survival of the others. Ask the students: *Is it ever right for people to be sacrificed to benefit the majority? Can you think of some situations where this has happened? Do you feel the right decisions were made?*

Authority: Clara uses the psychic paper to convince people she's from MI5 or Health and Safety. Apart from Fenton, they believe her and help her without question. Were people right to accept her authority? Is there a point when it is necessary to reject authority?

Discussion activities

Chapters I–2 Before reading

Discuss: In this story, the Doctor and Clara have to fight against aliens who are two-dimensional and come from a two-dimensional world. Put the students in small groups and ask them to discuss the following questions about dimensions: *How many dimensions do we live in? What are they?* (Conventionally, length, width and depth, with time often considered to be the fourth dimension.) *How many dimensions does the Doctor live in?* (He can travel through time.)

Have you ever seen a 3D film? Did you prefer it to normal films? Is 3D the way forward for cinemas?

After reading

2 Role play: Put the students in groups of three and tell them they are going to act out a TV interview. One of them is a manager from Community Payback, who is in favour of the scheme. Another is a politician who thinks prison is a better system, and the third is the interviewer. Ask them to consider deterrence, keeping offenders separate from society, rehabilitation and punishment.

Chapters 3-4

While reading

3 Discuss and artwork: Ask the students to read to p. 13, after 'The TARDIS was there at her feet but it was very small now, only about 15 centimetres high.' Put the students in small groups and ask them to discuss the following: The TARDIS is getting smaller but inside it is still very big. If you were the Doctor, what would you have in the TARDIS? Would you have a swimming pool, a gym, a music studio, a supermarket, a garden ...? Design your own TARDIS.

After reading

4 Pair work: Ask the students, in pairs, to prepare a summary of Chapters 3–4. They can take notes if they like. Then ask them to tell their stories to the rest of the class, who vote for the best one.

Chapter 5

While reading

5 Read carefully and discuss: Put students in small groups. Tell them to read the conversation between Clara and Danny on pp. 23–24. Clara doesn't tell Danny the whole truth. Ask the students if it is sometimes acceptable not to tell the truth. If they think so, ask them to discuss situations where they might do this.

Chapters 6-7

Before reading




