


Who's this? [Harry] Who's this? [Aunt Fifi] Who are Harry and Aunt Fifi looking for? [Waldo]






Story card 2



Have you got a small, green dragon? No, sorry.

Pointing to the teller. Has he got Waldo? [No, he hasn't.] Is Waldo big or small? [Small] Can the man help Harry? [No]








Excuse me. Have you got my dragon? He's green and he's got two wings. No, I'm sorry.


What colour is Waldo? [Green] *Pointing to the woman.* Has she got Waldo? [No, she hasn't.] Has Waldo got four wings? [No, he hasn't. He's got two wings.]






Pointing to the man. Has he got a frog? [Yes, he has. He's got a big frog.] Pointing to the man. Has he got Waldo. [No, he hasn't.] Is it a good idea to have a place for lost pets? (L1) [Encourage pupils to talk about where and why we might need a place for lost pets.]





Pointing to the fire. What colour is it? [It's yellow.] *Pointing to the fire.* What's this? [Pupils' own answers]
